Dear Members;


E-Waste Pick Up



he San Marino Chamber of Commere is in the final approval stages to add Visa and MasterCard as means to pay your membership dues. Once approved, the Chamber will begin accepting Visa and MasterCard for yearly dues payments. Fill out a one time form that will include your Credit Card of choice as well as a signature to keep on file, which will eliminate the need for costly invoicing and statements. Each year on the anniversary of your renewal, your Credit Card will automatically be billed. We expect this service to be up and running by mid February.
